Special Assessment Proposed for 2022 Budget

The Board is proposing a hopefully one-year additional assessment of \$50.00 to repair the damaged shoreline at the Twin Lakes Pond. The erosion has caused the shore to change from a gentle slope to a severe drop, causing soil to fall into the pond and create a condition of disappearing shoreline and ultimately will continue to reduce the effectiveness of the pond as a water retention device. The current Board has strived to maintain a stable assessment for the past few years but we feel this problem needs to be addressed as soon as possible. The most economical approach is to install "riprap" along the shoreline, similar to what has been done at the other two ponds. We are still attempting to reduce the cost, but as of this time, the cost appears to be approx. \$100,000. We have modified various catagories in the budget in an attempt to reduce the impact to the assessment. We hope for your understanding in this major project.
